Basic sewing supplies:

- Sewing machine, thread to match projects, scissors to cut fabric, small ruler (3" or so)
- Lunch

I will provide some zipper pulls to choose from, the wood frames and staples for the framed quilt and a sweet treat (can't stop baking).

ZIPPERED POUCH



Materials list:

- 2 quilted panels
 - Suggested sizes 8" x 10", 10" x 10", 10" x 12" or 12" x 12" (picture uses 8" x 10" panels)
 - Densely quilted will stand up better than a loose floppy panel
 - With or without a backing fabric
- 2 inside panels the same size as your outside quilted panels
- 14" zipper (I like Noodlehead zippers.)
- Zipper tab 4" x 4" fabric

Optional:

- Inside pocket 9" x width of your panel
- Handle 4" x 7" minimum for small handle as seen in photo.
- Zipper pull we'll talk about options
- Label I used a wooden "handmade" label but I've also used interesting ones taken from my clothes.

FRAMED QUILT

Materials list:

- 5 ½" x 5 ½" quilted panel
- 3 1/4" x 27" strip to match panel white is not recommended as you can see the wood through it.
